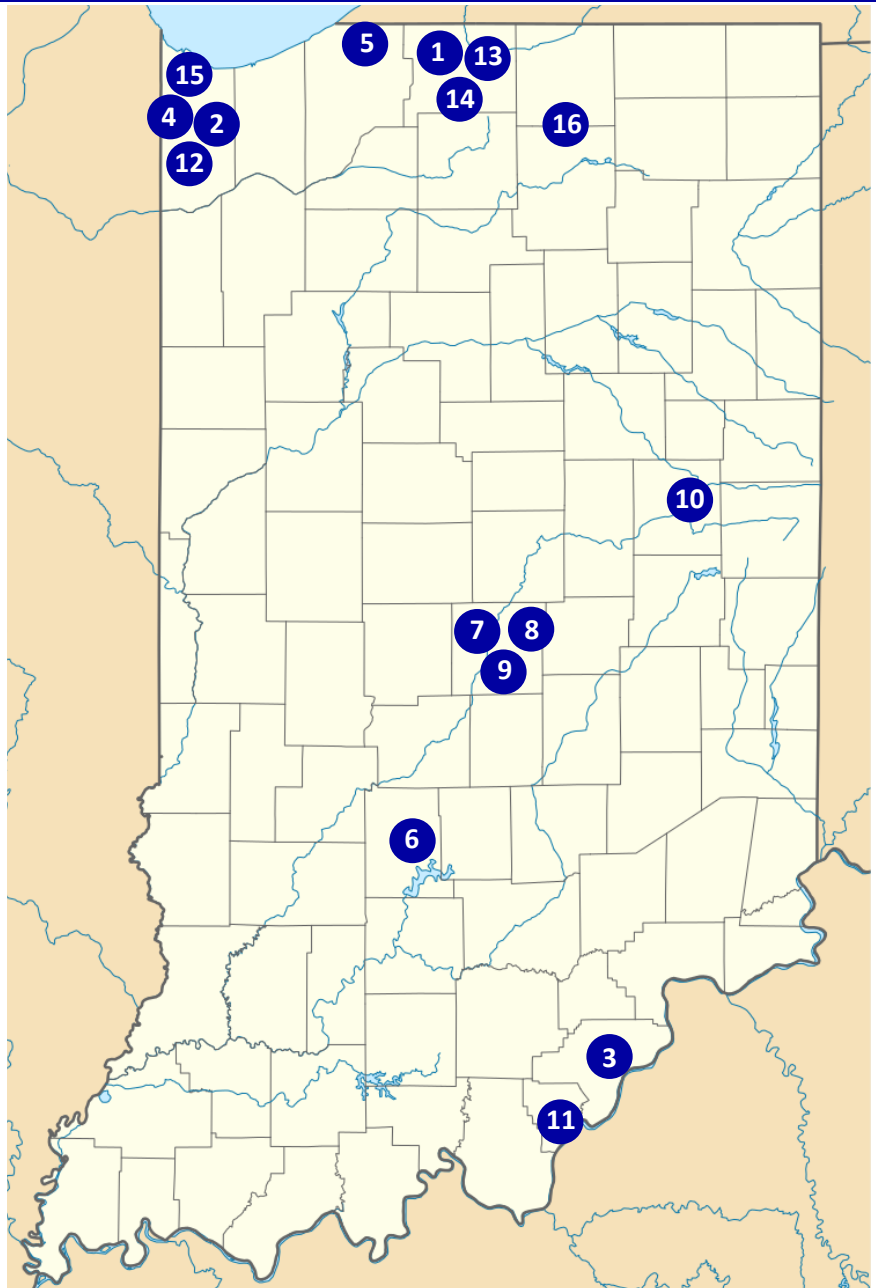


August 2020 South Shore Clean Cities Successful Indiana Volkswagen Grant Awards



On August 19, 2020, the Indiana Volkswagen Environmental Mitigation Trust Fund Committee approved successful grant applications, written by South Shore Clean Cities on behalf of its members and partners. The map to the right shows the location of each successful project. The projects involve a total of 120 vehicles including refuse trucks, transit buses, school buses, municipal snow plow/dump trucks and a concrete ready mix truck with fueling systems ranging from compressed natural gas to liquid propane gas, clean diesel and electric.
